This issue of *Materials Research* includes 22 articles selected from regular submissions in the period 2003-2005. We are now implementing a software system for **on-line submissions** with obvious advantages to authors and editors. The next issue of *Mat. Res.* will also be composed of regular articles. In parallel, we will be processing and selecting papers presented in a biomaterials conference, COLAOB (**Congresso latinoamericano de orgãos artificiais e biomateriais**) to be held in August, 2006.
