The review process for most of these papers was done via internet. Dozens of regular articles are being reviewed at present.

Materials Research is indexed in the Chemical Abstracts, World Ceramic Abstracts, International Pool of Glass Abstracts, Scielo, and in the powerful electronic database SCOPUS (<http://www.scopus.com/scopus/home.url>), which allows one to search articles by title, keyword, author name, etc., and also shows article citations. Recently we renewed our contact with the ISI staff and were told that the indexation process is underway.
