

Brazilian Guidelines on Rhinosinusitis

In 1999, Brazilian Journal of Otorhinolaryngology and Head and Face Surgery published the I Brazilian Consensus on Rhinosinusitis. The document intended to regulate management, diagnosis and treatment of rhinosinusitis.
